

How are the wires connected in the distribution box

Outgoing Circuit Wires

From the breakers, wires are routed to different areas of the building:

- Live Wire:** Runs from the breaker to the load (appliances, lights, outlets) to supply power.
- Neutral Wire:** Returns current from the load back to the neutral busbar.
- Earth Wire:** Ensures safety by connecting metallic parts of appliances to the earth busbar.
