

How many live wires are grounded in a household electrical distribution box

Live wires in a household electrical distribution box are not grounded; only neutral and ground wires are connected to the grounding system. In a standard household electrical system, there are three main types of conductors: live (hot) wires, neutral wires, and ground (earth) wires. Grounding is strictly reserved for neutral and earth wires to ensure electrical safety and prevent electrocution.
