These features help protect industrial networks from unauthorized access, man-in-the-middle attacks, and other cyber threats. Unmanaged switches, which are popular due to cost and ease of installation, lack advanced security controls and can be exploited by attackers to gain access to critical systems . Once compromised, attackers can capture network traffic, identify connected devices, and target sensitive assets such as IP surveillance systems or control systems .
