Main Switch Placement The main switch or main MCB is the primary control for the entire electrical supply and should be installed at the top or upper section of the distribution box for easy access during emergencies or maintenance. In domestic setups, a double-pole MCB rated for the maximum current (commonly 63A for single-phase systems) is used as the main switch, connecting the incoming phase and neutral lines. This ensures that turning off the main switch disconnects power from all downstream circuits.

Protective Devices Below the main switch, RCCBs (Residual Current Circuit Breakers) or RCDs should be installed. These devices monitor current flow and provide protection against earth faults or leakage currents, enhancing safety for users. Following the RCCBs, branch MCBs are placed for individual circuits. Single-pole MCBs are typically used for lighting, outlets, and small appliances, while double-pole MCBs may be used for high-power loads like water heaters or air conditioners.

Busbars and Wiring Busbars, usually copper strips, are mounted behind the breakers to distribute power efficiently. Using a comb busbar is recommended for neat connections and balanced load distribution. Neutral and earth bars should be positioned to allow proper grounding and completion of circuits.

Spacing and Accessibility Switches should be arranged to allow adequate spacing for safe operation and maintenance. NEC guidelines recommend a minimum clearance of 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high in front of the panel to ensure safe access. The panel door should open fully to 90° without obstruction.
