

How to build a metal spectrometer

Test with Metal Samples: Shine a flame on metal salts (e.g., copper, sodium, potassium) and observe the emission lines through the slit and grating. Each metal produces a unique spectral pattern, allowing identification.

- Keep the slit as narrow as possible to improve resolution.
- Ensure the enclosure is light-tight to prevent interference.
- Use a stable light source and avoid vibrations during measurement.
