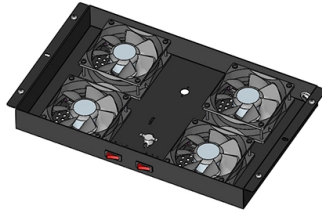

- Width:** 50mm to 900mm, depending on the number of cables and load requirements. Small widths are used for a few data lines, while large widths accommodate heavy industrial cabling.
- Depth (Side Wall Height):** 50mm to 150mm, ensuring cables remain secure and maintain proper spacing for heat dissipation.
- Length:** Typically 3 meters (10 feet), which balances ease of transport and installation. Some regions also use 2.5m or 6m sections.
