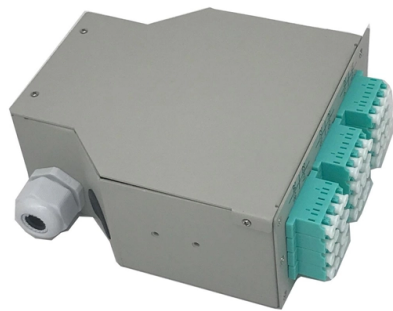


How to connect a 12-core fiber optic cable to a 24-core cable

- Polarity and Fiber Mapping:** MPO/MTP connectors are keyed and often marked with a white dot to indicate the first fiber. Proper alignment ensures that transmit fibers on the 12-core cable match the receive fibers on the 24-core cable.
- Male/Female Connectors:** MPO connectors come in male (with pins) and female (without pins). Ensure the correct mating type to avoid damaging fibers.
- Network Speed Compatibility:** Check that the fiber counts align with your transceiver technology (e.g., 40G, 100G, 200G). A 12-core MPO may leave some fibers unused when connecting to a 24-core trunk, which is acceptable if planned for redundancy or future upgrades.

Practical Steps

- Install a 12-core/24-core distribution box in your rack or patch panel.
- Connect the 24-core MPO trunk cable to the back of the distribution box.
- Use MPO-to-LC or MPO-to-SC jumpers to connect the front LC/SC adapters to your 12-core equipment...
