Use dedicated bolts or terminals, preferably with serrated washers, to pierce oxide layers and maintain low contact resistance.
- Flexible Bonding for Moving Parts** If the flat steel connection involves doors or panels, use braided copper tape or flexible conductors to maintain continuity while allowing movement. This prevents breaks in the grounding path and ensures the enclosure remains at the same potential.
- Surface Preparation and Anti-Corrosion Measures** Clean the steel surfaces to remove paint, oxide, or debris before connecting. Applying a small amount of conductive grease can reduce electrochemical corrosion and maintain low resistance over time.
- Verify Ground Resistance** After installation, measure the resistance from any point on the steel connection to the main grounding electrode. The total resistance should be below 0.1 Ohm for industrial systems, and a maximum of 25 Ohms is recommended for general distribution boxes. Parallel grounding paths can be used to reduce resistance when multiple spindles or long cables are involved.
