

# How to connect the heat shrink tubing for fiber optic heating

Clean the connector end face with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol before testing. Test the fiber connection using a power meter and light source to verify optical loss and signal quality. If necessary, cover the terminated end with a dust cap for protection.
