4. Connect to the Earth Ground Lead the other end of the ground wire to a ground rod or central grounding point. The rod should be buried in the soil to provide a stable grounding path. Ensure the connection is tight and corrosion-resistant .
5. Test Grounding Resistance Use a ground resistance tester or voltmeter to measure the resistance. For household distribution boxes, the resistance should be less than 4 ohms, while industrial systems may require less than 0.1 ohm between system parts . If resistance is too high, add more ground rods or adjust their depth.
6. Connect Electrical Components If there are components inside the box that require grounding, connect them to the PE bar using copper wires. Ensure all connections are secure and clearly labeled for maintenance .
7. Backfill and Inspect After installation, backfill any trenches and compact the soil. Regularly inspect the grounding connections to ensu...

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.
