Clearance and Fill Rate: Ensure the trapezoidal tray maintains at least 50% cross-sectional fill to allow airflow and prevent overheating. Maintain minimum clearances from ceilings or walls to facilitate maintenance and inspection.

Material Selection: Choose tray materials based on environmental conditions. Aluminum offers corrosion resistance, while stainless steel provides high strength and durability in harsh environments. Pre-galvanized steel is suitable for general indoor applications.
