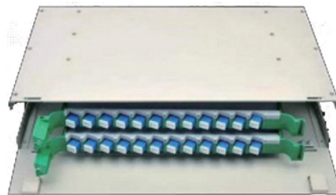


How to disable a relay protection device

Restoration: After maintenance or testing, relays must be re-enabled and tested to ensure proper operation before returning the system to normal service ().

Considerations

Coordination: Ensure that disabling one relay does not compromise the protection of other system components.

Documentation: Record all actions, including the reason for disabling, duration, and personnel involved.

Testing: After reactivation, perform functional tests to verify that the relay operates correctly under simulated fault conditions.

Regulatory Compliance: Follow local standards and utility regulations, as improper handling can violate safety codes and insurance requireme...
