

How to disconnect a surveillance fiber optic cable

6. Handle with Care Work slowly and avoid rushing. Even microscopic dust or scratches on the fiber tip can degrade signal quality. If the connector is stuck or damaged, contact a professional technician rather than forcing removal .

Safety Precautions Never look directly into the fiber end or transceiver. Do not touch the glass ferrule at the connector tip. Use proper ESD precautions when handling transceivers...
