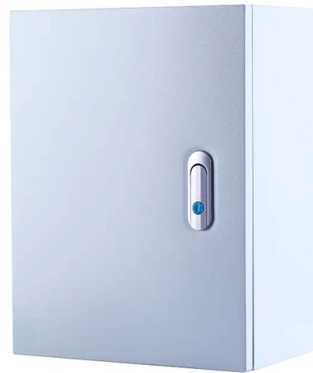


How to install the panel after the fiber optic cable is connected
