- Connect ONT to Router:** Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN or fiber-designated port. Power on the router and verify connectivity through indicator lights.
- Configure Router Settings:** Access the router's admin interface to configure WAN settings, VLANs, or PPPoE credentials as required by you...
