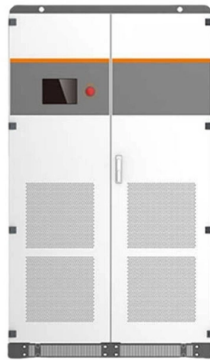


How to protect cable trays passing through walls

Firestopping and Sealing Cable trays penetrating walls must be sealed with fire-rated materials to prevent the spread of fire and smoke. Use firestop packs, firestop mastic, fire-resistant mineral wool, or fire-rated boards to fill gaps around the tray, ensuring no visible cracks or voids. For large openings, install a fire-resistant backing plate before sealing. The gap between firestop materials and cables should not exceed 1 cm², and packing thickness should meet design requirements. Cover plates should be square, properly sized, and painted evenly to close the opening.

Mechanical Protection Cable trays should not be used as walkways and must be protected from mechanical damage, especially in areas prone to impact or dust. When passing through walls, ensure the tray is properly supported with arms spaced 1.5–3 meters apart, and avoid placing direct plate connections at mid-span or support points. Protective covers should be installed on trays in outdoor or high-risk areas, and vertical trays within 2 meters of the ground should also have covers.

Environmental Considerations For trays passing from indoors to outdoors, rainproofing measures are essential. Extend the tray downward before routing upward to prevent water ingress. In fireproof or explosion-proof environments, appropriate sealing devices must be installed to maintain the integrity of the protective barrier.

Grounding and Electrical Safety Metallic cable trays must be properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards and arcing. Grounding should be completed before cable installation and verified before energizing the system. Only cables approved for use in cable trays should be installed, and live parts must be d...
