- Additional specifications:** Model numbers may also include information about buffer diameter, minimum bend radius, maximum pulling tension, and distance markings for installation purposes.

Example of Reading a Model Number

For instance, a cable marked GYGZL03 can be interpreted as:

- GY: Outdoor optical cable
- G: Metal heavy-duty reinforcing member
- Z: Self-supporting structure
- L: Aluminum sheath
- 03: No armor layer, polyethylene sleeve

Similarly, a model number like SR-5B9MR-864 indicates a Corning SST UltraRibbon Gel-Free Cable with 864 fibers, low water peak single-mode fiber, and specific struc...
