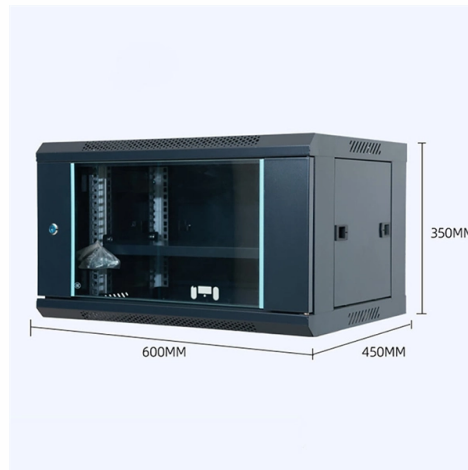


How to reconnect wires if the wiring in the distribution box is burnt out
