

How to remove the jumper cable from the optical module

Remove the Optical Module Hold the module by its edges or pull tab and pull it straight out horizontally. Avoid twisting or applying excessive force to prevent damage to the connectors or the slot.

Protect and Store the Module After removal, cover the module's optical port with a dust-proof cap. Inspect the module for any damage, especially the connectors and pins. Store it in an anti-static bag or blister box until reuse.

Cable Management If the fiber jumper is to be reused, clean the connector with an appropriate fiber cleaning tool before reinserting it into another module.

Additional Precautions Do not look directly into the optical port or fiber ends, as laser light can damage your eyes. Avoid bending the fiber cable beyond its minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss or damage. Label cables if multiple fibers are being removed to ensure correct reconnection. Following these steps ensures safe removal of optical jumper cables...
