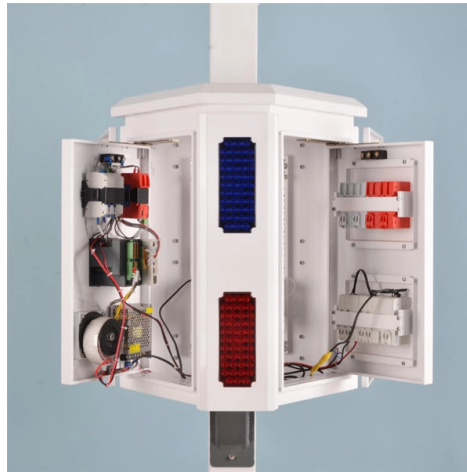


How to use the upper left bend of the cable tray



AI Overview

When routing a cable tray through an upper left bend, use the correct elbow type, respect the minimum bend radius, and account for cable crowding on the inside of the bend.

Bend Type and Orientation

For an upper left bend, the tray typically changes direction either horizontally or vertically. Choose the appropriate elbow fitting:

- Flat-wise elbow:** For horizontal turns across a ceiling or floor, keeping the tray flat while changing direction left or right ().
- Inside riser:** If the tray climbs vertically along a wall, the cables sit on the concave face of the bend, hugging the structure ().
- Outside riser:** If the tray moves away from the wall, the cables sit on the convex face, useful when transitioning from horizontal to vertical ().

Stand at the bend and determine which side the cable load naturally falls toward to select inside vs outside orientation. This ensures cables rest properly without sagging or fighting the fitting ().

Cable Crowding and Fill Considerations

Cables on the inside of the bend travel a shorter distance, which can lead to crowding and potential overfill (). To prevent this:

- Calculate fill capacity based on the inside radius, not the centerline radius ().
- Consider the tray type: ladder trays allow easy access and support for backbone cables, ventilated troughs reduce usable space due to slats, and wire mesh baskets have lower fill capacity ().
- Avoid sharp bends; maintain the minimum bend radius for the cable type to prevent damage ().
- For multiple bends, note that offsets increase total arc length and reduce effective fill, so plan accordingly ().

Support and Installation Tips

- Place supports close to the elbow on both sides to maintain stability ().
- Ensure the tray is mechanically secured to walls, ceilings, or racks to prevent sagging ().
- Use gradual bends rather than tight angles to reduce stress on cables and maintain proper airflow.
- Check that the total cable fill does not exceed the tray's rated capacity, esp...
