If space is limited, use single-bolt parallel groove connectors with heat shrink sleeves to safely combine wires while maintaining individual circuit protection. Secure Circuit Breakers: Insert each breaker into its slot and connect the outgoing circuit wires to the breaker terminals. Ensure all screws are tightened to the recommended torque to prevent loose connections. Communication and Control Wiring (if applicable): For systems with inverters or EPS parallel boxes, connect CAN or RS485 communication lines according to the manufacturer's instructions, ensuring correct polarity and torque specifications.
