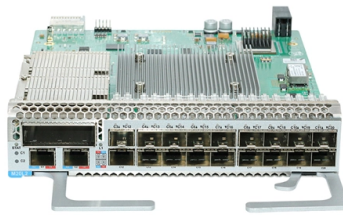


Huijue core layer switch automatically assigns IP addresses

Huijue core switches support the Dynamic Host Configuration Protocol (DHCP), which allows the switch to automatically assign IP addresses and other network parameters to client devices without manual configuration. The DHCP server on the switch operates in a client/server model, where the switch provides IP addresses from a predefined address pool to requesting devices (clients) on the network.

Address Pool Types

- Interface Address Pool** Used when the DHCP server and clients are on the same network segment. Simple to configure and suitable for small networks with limited devices. The switch assigns IP addresses only to devices connected to the specific interface.
- Global Address Pool** Suitable for large networks with multiple segments. Configured on the core switch or a dedicated DHCP server. Requires enabling DHCP relay on user gateways to forward requests to the core switch.

Configuration Overview

- Define an address pool with a range of IP addresses.
- Enable the DHCP server on the switch interface or globally.
- Optionally, configure excluded addresses to reserve certain IPs for static assignments.

Devices connected to the switch will automatically request an IP, and the switch assigns one from the pool, along with subnet mask, gateway, and DNS information.

- Centralized management:** Reduces manual IP configuration and errors.
- Efficient IP utilization:** Leases IP addresses for a limited time, allowing reuse.
- Scalability:** Supports both small and large networks with flexible pool configurations.
- Additional services:** Some switches can also provide automatic software updates or other network parameters...
