Splicing and Termination: Use fusion splicing for low-loss connections. Place fibers in the splice cassette and maintain a bend radius above 40mm to prevent signal degradation. Environmental Sealing: Ensure the closure is mechanically sealed and waterproof (IP68) to protect against moisture, dust, and UV exposure.
