

Installation distance of cable tray supports in underground trenches



Overview

2 M distance is maintained between the supports to avoid the sagging of trays and ladders. Cut the standard length/ladder to the required length with appropriate cutting tools. Clause 522-08-04 Where conductors or cables are not supported. This publication is intended as a practical guide for the proper and safe* installation of cable ladder systems, cable tray systems, channel support systems and associated supports. Cable ladder systems and cable tray systems shall be manufactured in accordance with BS EN 61537, channel support. When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. This spacing is crucial for adequate maintenance access, ease of inspection, and ensuring proper airflow for effective heat dissipation.
