

Installation of fiber optic junction boxes inside wells

Each fiber line is connected at one end to a bridge plug and at the other end to a surface cable. The deployment device ensures controlled spooling and prevents damage to the fibers during insertion into the casing.

Key considerations during deployment: Maintain the minimum bend radius of the fiber to prevent breakage. Use protective sleeves or conduits to shield fibers from mechanical stress and wellbore fluids. Avoid twisting or kinking the cable; figure-8 loops can be used when handling excess fiber. Ensure the fiber ends are capped to prevent contamination or moisture ingress.

Junction Box Installation Once the fiber reaches the surface or designated wellhead location: Select a secure, dry location for the junction box, avoiding direct sunlight or moisture exposure. Mark and drill mounting holes using a spirit level to ensure the box is straight. Insert dowels and secure the box with screws. Prepare the fiber cable by carefully stripping the outer sheath without damaging the fibers. Insert the fiber into the junction box and follow the ma...
