Typical spans for ladder-type trays range from 1.5 to 3 meters, but always follow manufacturer specifications and local electrical codes . Closer spacing may be required for heavy cables or long unsupported runs.
- 5. Installing the Cable Tray** Place the tray onto the mounted brackets. Secure the tray to the brackets using bolts or clamps as recommended by the manufacturer. Check that the tray is level and that there is no sag between supports .
- 6. Cable Management and Safety** Once the tray is installed, lay cables carefully, maintaining minimum bend radius and avoiding overcrowding. Install covers if required to protect cables from debris or environmental exposure. Label the tray system and inspect for proper alignment and secure fastening .
