Wiring Steps Mount the distribution box securely on a wall, ensuring it is level and stable. Connect the main supply: Live (phase), neutral, and earth wires from the main supply should be connected to the main isolator or double-pole MCB. Install the lighting MCB: Connect the live wire from the main bus bar to the input terminal of the lighting MCB. The neutral wire should connect to the neutral bus bar, and the earth wire to the grounding bus. Run cables to lights: From the output terminal of the MCB, run the live wire to the light switch, then from the switch to the light fixture. Connect the neutral wire directly from the neutral bus bar to the light fixture, and the earth wire to the fixture's grounding terminal. Neat arrangement: Use cable ties to organize wires inside the box, leaving space for heat dissipation and avoiding contact with sharp edges.

Testing After wiring, perform an insulation resistance test to ensure no short circuits or leakage. Then, switch on th...
