

Installing cable trays above the cold storage



AI Overview

Cable trays in cold storage should be installed using corrosion-resistant materials, proper support systems, and careful routing to accommodate low temperatures and high humidity. **Material Selection** In cold storage environments, humidity and condensation are major concerns. Use stainless steel (AISI 316L) or hot-dip galvanized steel for cable trays to prevent corrosion and ensure long-term durability . Solid covers help protect sensitive instrumentation cables from moisture . Maintain horizontal and vertical runs only, avoiding unnecessary bends to reduce stress on cables during installation and operation . Ensure adequate clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance, and coordinate tray routes to avoid clashes with other services . Use spacers or supports to keep cables organized and prevent sagging, especially on long runs . **Support and Installation** Install trays on rigid supports such as threaded rods, brackets, or wall-mounted hangers, spaced according to tray type and load. Typical spacing is 1-1.5 meters for horizontal runs . Inspect all materials on-site for damage or discrepancies before installation. Remove unsuitable materials immediately . Store trays horizontally on flat surfaces with timber supports to prevent deformation before installation . **Safety and Standards** Follow BS EN 61537 or equivalent standards for cable tray systems to ensure mechanical and electrical safety . Cable trays are supports for cables only, not walkways or ladders, to prevent personal injury and system damage . Ensure compliance with local electrical codes a...
