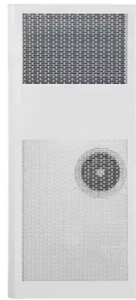


Is a three-level distribution box the same as a switch box

Key Distinction While the switch box forms the tertiary level of a three-level distribution system, the term "three-level distribution box" refers to the entire hierarchical system, including primary, secondary, and tertiary levels. Therefore, a switch box is a component of the three-level distribution system, not the system as a whole.
