Fiber optic ducts alongside highways should be laid in properly excavated trenches at regulated depths, with protective measures and permissions to ensure long-term service and safety. Planning and Permissions Before any installation, it is essential to obtain permissions from road and rail authorities for laying ducts along highways and at crossings. The route should be finalized based on surveys, avoiding burrow pits and areas prone to future road widening. Typically, ducts are laid along the road boundary or at least 15 meters from the centerline where road land is wide enough to prevent future disruptions. Trenching and Depth Trenching is the standard method for underground duct installation. Trenches are usually 1–1.65 meters deep, with a width of 250–300 mm at the bottom to accommodate ducts and protective layers. The trench bottom should be horizontal and free of stones, and transitions between hard and soft surfaces should be tamped to prevent cable damage. In colder climates, deeper burial may be required to avoid frost damage. Duct Materials and Protection HDPE ducts are commonly used, sometimes with innerduct liners for easier cable pulling. In areas with high risk of mechanical damage, additional protection like RCC or GI pipes may be installed over the ducts. Marker tapes should be buried above the ducts (typically 300 mm below the surface) to warn future excavators. Installation Techniques Horizontal Directional Drilling (HDD) is preferred for crossing roads, railways, or other obstacles to minimize surface disruption. Ducts should be laid as straight as possible, with pre-formed bends used where necessary. Manholes or handholes should be installed at intervals for cable access, splicing, and maintenance. Backfilling and Safety Trenches should be backfilled carefully to avoid damaging ducts. Traffic safety measures, such as signage and barriers, are required...
