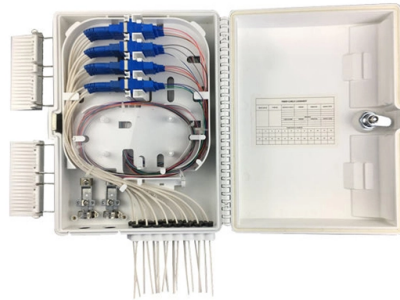


Moving and modifying cable trays

Loading and Unloading: Trays should be handled gently using lifting equipment or manual handling techniques that avoid direct contact with edges or surfaces. Avoid dropping trays or stacking them in a way that could cause deformation.

Positioning for Installation: Mark the tray routes according to approved shop drawings, maintaining horizontal and vertical runs. Supports such as threaded rods, 'L' angles, or slotted 'C' channels should be installed at intervals (maximum 1.2 meters) to prevent sagging. Bends, branches, and offsets require additional support.

Cable Pulling Considerations: When installing cables into trays, use rollers at corners and intermediate points to prevent excessive tension or bending. Ensure cables are not twisted, and maintain the manufacturer-recommend...
