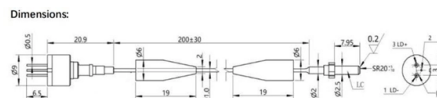

- Cable Opening and Preparation**Before splicing or connecting, the cable must be carefully opened:
 - Removing Outer Sheath:** Use specialized fiber strippers to remove the protective jacket without damaging the inner fibers.
 - Cleaving Fibers:** Fibers are cut cleanly using precision cleavers to ensure a smooth end face for splicing.
 - Handling Precautions:** Avoid sharp bends, excessive tension, or contact with abrasive surfaces. Use figure-8 loops to prevent twisting du...
