Connection Methods Proper connection of fiber optic modules involves several key steps: Verify Compatibility: Ensure the module type, fiber type (single-mode or multimode), connector type (LC, SC, FC), and data rate match the network requirements. Prepare Components: Use ESD protection, clean the module ports and fiber connectors with lint-free wipes and isopropyl alcohol, and inspect cables for damage. Install the Module: Power down the host device, align the module with the port (matching TX/RX labels), and insert gently until the latch clicks.
