Understanding Pin Fiber Optic Cables

Transportation Guidelines

Drum Handling

Always move fiber optic cable drums in an upright position; never lay them flat or horizontally, as this can crush the lower layers and damage fibers. Use forklifts with forks longer than the drum width and slightly tilt the drum to keep it secure. Raise forks at least 6–8 inches from the ground before moving. For heavy or long drums, use a shaft through the drum center and a spreader bar to prevent flange compression.

Rolling and Placement

Roll drums in the direction indicated on the drum to avoid loosening or kinking the cable. Once positioned, secure drums with stoppers to prevent accidental rolling.

Cable Protection

Avoid exceeding the minimum bend radius during transport, pulling, or installation, as this can cause microbends or fiber breakage. Do not twist, pinch, or apply excessive tensile load to the cable. Use proper pulling grips and tension control for long runs. Protect MPO/MTP connectors from contamination, scratches, and misalignment during handling.

Storage Considerations

Maintain sufficient spacing between drums to prevent damage from forklift forks or other drums. Store in a clean, dry environment to avoid moisture or dust contamination.
