Fiber Splicing Methods Two primary splicing techniques are used: Fusion Splicing: Uses an electric arc to fuse fiber ends, creating a near-seamless connection with extremely low signal loss (often below 0.1 dB). This method is preferred for long-haul and high-performance networks due to its reliability and minimal attenuation. Mechanical Splicing: Aligns fiber ends using a small device and index-matching gel. It is faster and easier in the field but generally results in higher signal loss and is less permanent than fusion splicing. Key Features...
