Dome-headed bolts, nuts, and washers suitable for the tray material should be used for connections.

Busbar Trunking Installation requires precise assembly of components such as joints, expansion sections, bends, and tap-off units. Misalignment or improper torque can cause electrical faults, overheating, or mechanical instability.
