Double-sealed silicone gaskets are commonly used to enhance waterproofing and prevent moisture intrusion. Electrical enclosures must comply with IEC 60364, IEC 61439, and BS 7671 standards, which specify requirements for accessibility, safety, and protection of electrical panels. The door should allow safe operation, maintenance, and inspection while providing adequate clearance around the panel for working space. For industrial installations, the enclosure should also support mounting of switchgear and circuit breakers with proper spacing and secure fastening.
