

# Required dimensions for the front and rear passageways of the distribution box

The minimum front clearance for a distribution box is 3 feet (914 mm), and the rear passageway should be at least 1.5 meters wide, with sufficient height for safe access.

**Front Clearance** For safe operation and maintenance, the front of the distribution box must have a minimum clearance of 3 feet (914 mm). **Rear Clearance** The rear passageway of the cabinet should be at least 1.5 meters wide to allow safe access for installation, inspection, and maintenance. The base of the cabinet should be properly insulated and elevated, typically around 2.3 meters above the ground, depending on the installation site. This clearance ensures that personnel can work safely behind the equipment without obstruction.

**Side and Additional Clearances**

**Side clearance:** Minimum 30 inches (762 mm) from the sides of the equipment, or at least equal to the width of the equipment itself, to provide side-to-side working space.

**Equipment spacing in rows:** For low-voltage distribution boxes installed in rows, aisles should be maintained, and additional exits provided if the total row length exceeds 5 meters to ensure emergency egress.

**Obstructions:** No pipes, cabinets, or other equipment should block the front or rear passageways. The working space must remain clear at all times.
