They should be mounted on a firm bracket or foundation and measures should be taken to prevent climbing or tampering. Waterproof enclosures and rain covers are recommended for additional protection.

Ground-Mounted Boxes For ground-mounted boxes, the foundation should raise the box 50 to 100 mm (2 to 4 inches) above ground level to prevent moisture damage and ensure stability.
