Methods to Replace FC with SC

Using FC-to-SC Adapters

FC-to-SC adapters allow you to connect existing FC-type fiber cables to devices with SC ports without changing the cabling infrastructure. These adapters are widely used in routers and network processors, such as Cisco 4000, 7000, and 7500 series, to maintain compatibility between older FC equipment and newer SC-based devices.

Replacing Transceivers

If your device supports SFP or SFP+ modules, you can replace the FC transceiver with an SC-compatible SFP module. Ensure the module matches the fiber type (single-mode or multi-mode) and the required data rate. SC SFP modules are typically used in single-fiber or PON applications, while FC SFPs are used in SAN environments.

Configuring Interfaces on Gateways

In SAN gateways that act as FCoE-FC bridges, you must explicitly configure the physical interfaces you want to use as FC interfaces. By default, all interfaces may be Ethernet, so converting to SC may involve both physical adapter installation and software configuration to recognize the new interface type.

Best Practices

Check Compatibility: Ensure the adapter or transceiver supports the fiber type and data rate of your network.
