While Sierra Leone has extensive fiber deployment, there is no publicly available information indicating the presence of a local factory producing these junction boxes. Most junction boxes in African fiber networks are typically imported from specialized manufacturers abroad, given the technical precision required for fiber splicing and protection. Challenges and Considerations The network faces several operational challenges: Power reliability: Frequent outages in the national grid require reliance on diesel generators and solar power, which can affect network performance. Cable damage: Approximately 90% of backbone cable damages are due to vandalism, often from misconceptions about the value of fiber cables. Infrastructure maintenance: A...
