

Size of the main switch in the distribution box

The main switch in a distribution box should be rated according to the total load of the installation and the type of supply, typically ranging from 40A to 100A for residential systems and higher for commercial or industrial setups.

Understanding the Main Switch
The main switch (or main circuit breaker) is the primary device that controls the flow of electricity into the distribution box. - Total Load of the Installation:** Calculate the sum of all connected loads (lighting, appliances, HVAC, etc.) in amperes. The main switch rating should exceed this total load to prevent nuisance tripping.
- Supply Type:** Single-phase systems typically use 40-100A main switches, while three-phase systems may require 100A or more depending on the building's power demand.
- Cable and Busbar Ratings:** The main switch must match the current-carrying capacity of incoming cables and busbars to ensure safe operation.
- Short-Circuit Protection:** The switch should have a short-circuit breaking capacity suitable for the maximum prospective fault current at the installation point.
- Regulatory Standards:** Compliance with local codes such as NEC, IEC, or BS 7671 is essential. These standards define minimum ratings, clearances, and installation practices.

Typical Residential Example

- Single-phase home: Main switch rating 63A-100A, double-pole, 230V supply.
- Three-phase small commercial: Main switch rating 100A-250A, three-pole or four-pole, 400V supply.
- Industrial or high-load buildings: MCCBs rated 250A-630A or higher, depending on total connected load and fault current.
