Safety Measures: Each tertiary box typically follows the principle of “one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box”, providing independent protection for each appliance. Residual Current Devices (RCDs) are installed at this level to ensure final protection.

Construction Sites: In temporary setups, such as construction sites, tertiary boxes may be movable to accommodate changing equipment locations while maintaining safety standards.

Follow key principles: no cross-level wiring, one machine-one switch, $\leq 30\text{m}$ box spacing, dry/ventilated installation for safe distribution.

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Generally, the first-level distribution box is required to be installed in a place with a relatively high terrain, dry and ventilated, and the second-level and third-level distribution boxes
