- Stainless Steel (316SS):** Superior resistance to harsh marine, chemical, or industrial environments; ideal for areas with high chloride or acidic exposure.
- FRP:** Non-conductive, UV-resistant, and chemically inert; excellent for corrosive or sensitive electronic environments, though more expensive.

Environmental factors such as salt spray, chemical fumes, acidic rain, high humidity, and solar radiant heat must be considered when selecting materials.

Mechanical Strength and Load Capacity Outdoor trays must support the weight of installed cables and withstand environmental stresses:

- Span and support spacing:** Determines tray deflection and load capacity; longer spans require stronger materials or additional supports.
- Impact resistance:** Important in areas prone to debris or mechanical contact.
- Cable support:** Ladder and perforated trays provide better ventilation and even support, reducing insulation stress.

Types of Outdoor Cable Trays

- Ladder trays:** Open design, excellent for heat dissipation, suitable for power cables with high ampacity; rungs typically spaced 6–12 inches.
- Perforated trays:** Ventilated bottom, good for small-diameter cables, moderate heat...
