It provides load/span class designations and guidance for installation in accordance with the National Electrical Code (NEC) (Cable Tray Institute).

IEC 61537 is the international standard for cable tray systems, covering mechanical strength, corrosion resistance, electrical continuity, fire resistance, ventilation, fill ratio, and installation compatibility. It applies to steel, stainless steel, aluminum, and other metallic trays, ensuring safety and performance across industrial and commercial environments.

UL 568 addresses performance requirements for fiberglass cable trays but is often referenced for structural safety and load testing in mixed-material installations.

NEC (NFPA 70) and **CEC (C22.1 Part 1)** provide installation rules, including ampacity, conductor spacing, and support methods, which are critical for steel support design.

Material and Corrosion Protection Steel cable tray supports are typically made from carbon steel or stainless steel, with surface treatments such as hot-dip galvanization, pre-galvanization, or stainless steel alloys (e.g., AISI 316L) to enhance corrosion resistance in industrial or outdoor environments. Stainless steel may include chromium and molybdenum for improved resistance to chlorides and chemical exposure.

Mechanical and Seismic Considerations Steel supports must withstand dead loads (tray, cables, and permanently attached items) and live loads (temporary construction loads). Seismic design is addressed in standards like NEMA and project...
