 - Wi-Fi 4 (802.11n) typically maxes out around 600 Mbps in ideal conditions.
 - Wi-Fi 5 (802.11ac) can reach up to 3.5 Gbps theoretically, but real-world speeds are often lower.
 - Wi-Fi 6 (802.11ax) supports up to 9.6 Gbps theoretically, with practical speeds around 1-2 Gbps for compatible devices.

- Ethernet Cable Quality:** Use Cat6a or higher to prevent bottlenecks between the ONT and router.
- Wi-Fi Interference:** Distance from the router, walls, and other electronic devices can reduce wireless speeds.
- Device Compatibility:** Older devices may not support the latest Wi-Fi standards, limiting achievable speeds.
