Explosion Protection Types

- Flameproof (Ex d):** Enclosures withstand internal explosions and prevent flame propagation to the surrounding atmosphere.
- Increased Safety (Ex e):** Enhances component safety to avoid sparks or excessive heat.
- Intrinsic Safety (Ex i):** Limits circuit energy so that even under fault conditions, ignition cannot occur.
- Oil/Sand-Filled (Ex o / Ex q):** Uses special media to prevent flame or heat transfer, suitable for specific applications.

Material and Construction Requirements

- Enclosure Materials:** Commonly glass fiber reinforced polyester (GRP), stainless steel, or aluminum, chosen for mechanical strength, corrosion resistance, and temperature tolerance.
- Ingress Protection:** IP65 or higher is recommended; IP66/IP67 is preferred for outdoor or wash-down environments.
- NEMA Ratings:** NEMA 4X provides corrosion resistance for harsh chemical or marine environments.
- Heat Dissipation:** Proper design ensures internal components do not overheat while maintaining explosion-proof integrity.

Application Considerations

- Hazardous Area Classification:** Select boxes according to Zone 0/1/2 or Zone 20/21/22, or Class I/II Division 1/2.
