- Protection Types:** Choose based on hazard level: Ex d (flameproof), Ex i (intrinsic safety), Ex e (increased safety) depending on Zone classification.
- Wiring and Terminals:** Use galvanized fasteners, black secondary wiring with casing, and ensure neat bundling with nylon ties.
