Grounding and Earthing: Proper grounding protects both personnel and equipment from electrical faults.

Maintenance Access: Adequate working space around distribution boxes is required for safe inspection and maintenance.

Labeling and Documentation: Clear identification of circuits, hazards, and operating procedures is essential for safety and compliance.
