SFP+: Enhanced SFP supporting 10 Gbps, commonly used for data center uplinks or high-performance connections. QSFP/QSFP28: Higher-speed modules (40G/100G) for aggregation or core network links. Modules are available for single-mode fiber (SMF) for long distances and multimode fiber (MMF) for short to medium distances. Copper-based modules, such as Direct Attach Copper (DAC), are used for short-range connections. Compatibility Considerations Compatibility is critical. Even if a module matches the required speed and form factor, it may not be fully supported by the platform, leading to detection issues, link instability, or performance degradation. Always verify modules against the firewall or switch vendor's official compatibility list. Some devices have combo ports (RJ45/SFP), allowing only one interface type at a time, and certain models may not support auto-speed detection for higher-speed modules. Installation and Safety Proper handling is essential to avoid damage: ESD protection: Use anti-static precautions to prevent electrostatic discharge. Insertion/removal: Insert gently without excessive force to avoid damaging the SFP cage. Laser safety: Modern Class 1 modules are eye-safe, but avoid direct e...
